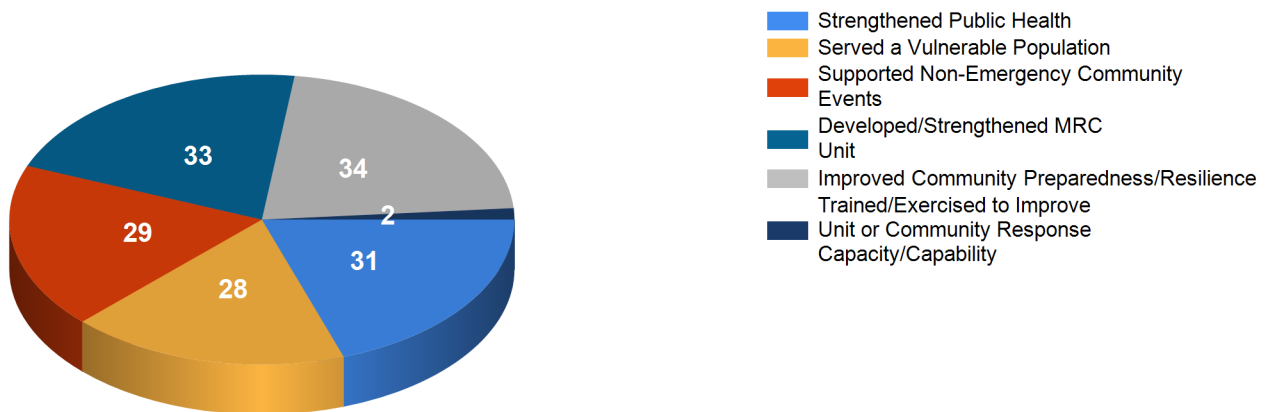

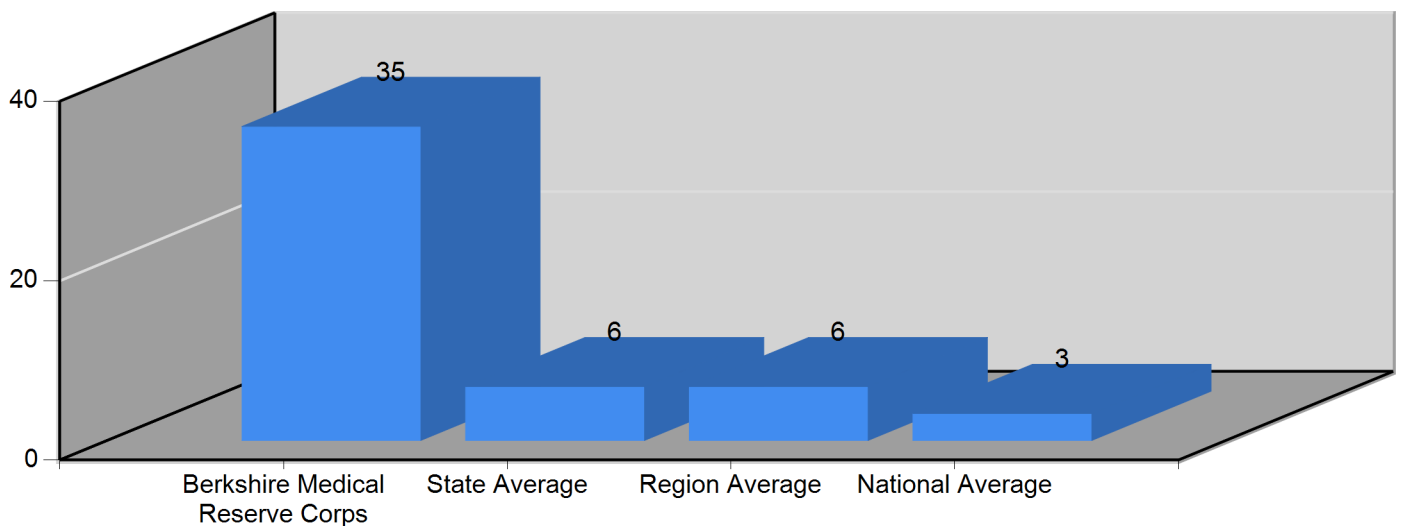

## Impact



Between October 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018, Berkshire Medical Reserve Corps reported a total of 35 activities. Because one activity can influence several impact areas, the total number of activities will not match the number of impact areas reflected in the pie chart. The total activities reported contributed to the following impact areas: 31 strengthened public health, 28 served a vulnerable population, 29 supported non-emergency community events, 33 developed/strengthened the MRC unit, 34 improved community preparedness/resilience, and 2 trained/exercised to improve unit or community response capacity/capability.

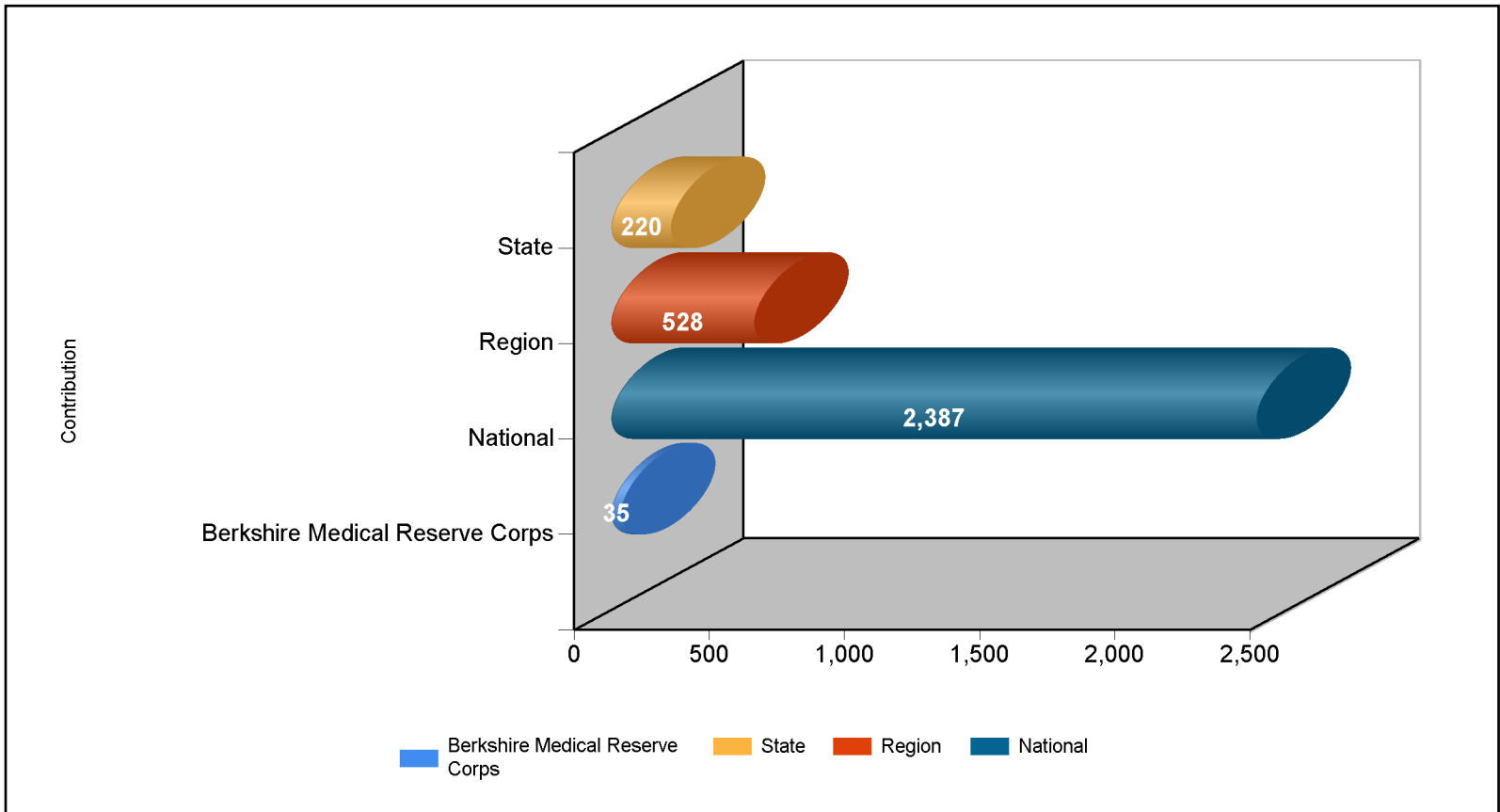
## Comparison: Number of Activities
