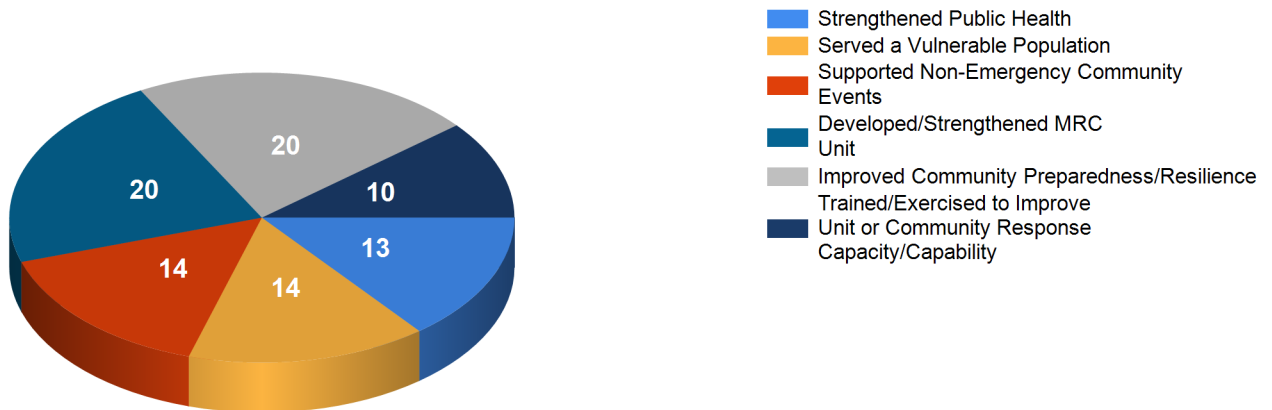

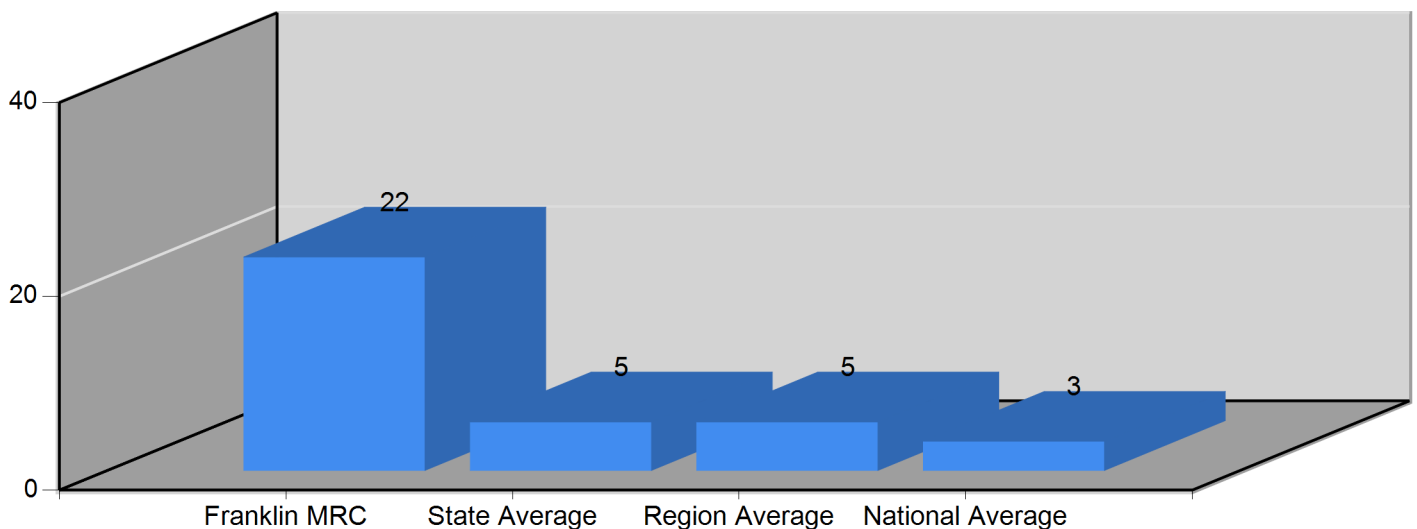

Impact



Between October 1, 2018 and December 31, 2018, Franklin MRC reported a total of 22 activities. Because one activity can influence several impact areas, the total number of activities will not match the number of impact areas reflected in the pie chart. The total activities reported contributed to the following impact areas: 13 strengthened public health, 14 served a vulnerable population, 14 supported non-emergency community events, 20 developed/strengthened the MRC unit, 20 improved community preparedness/resilience, and 10 trained/exercised to improve unit or community response capacity/capability.

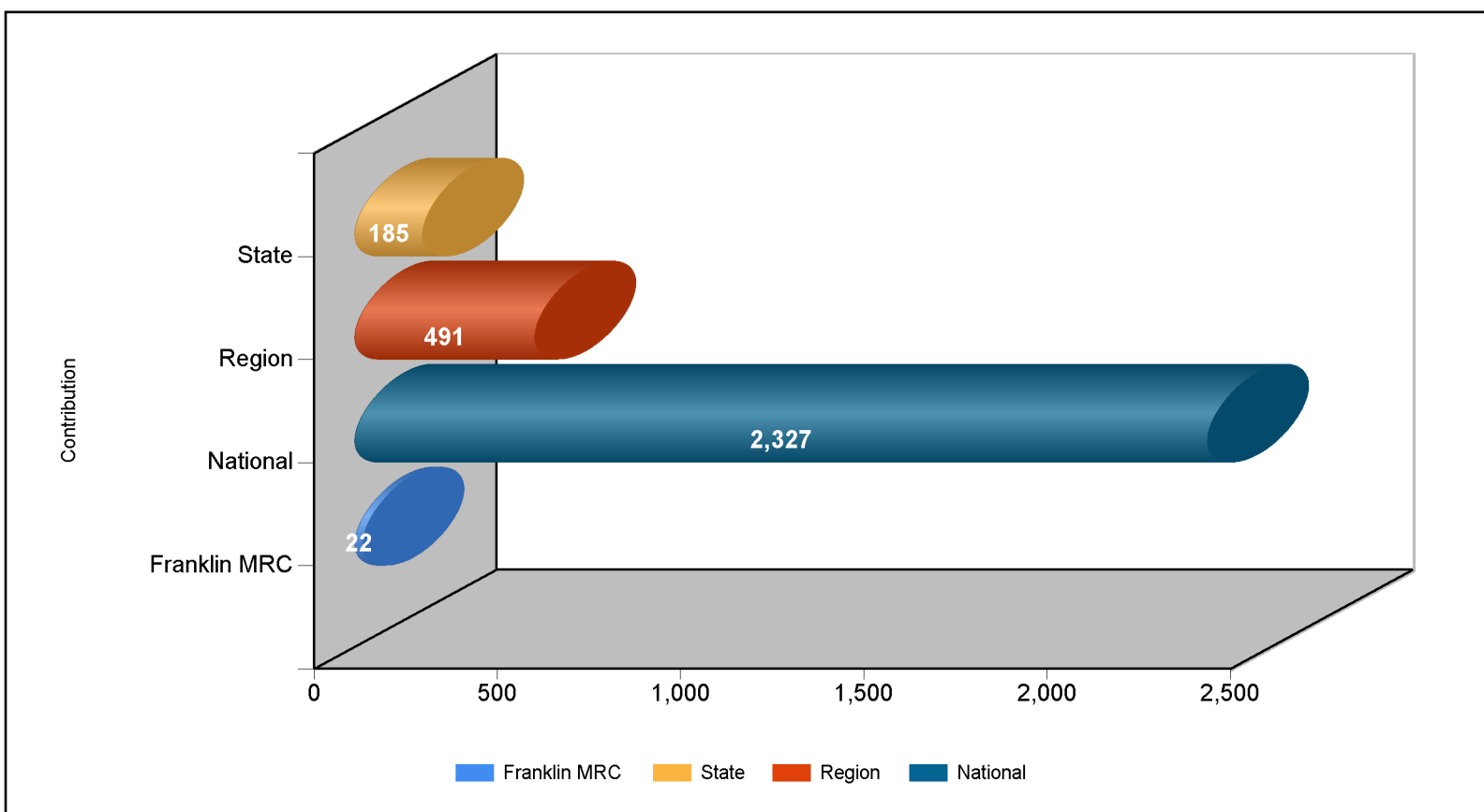
Comparison: Number of Activities
