- You have a specific role, and it's important that you remain in this role and not try to do something else – even if you are qualified to do so. *We know this is sometimes difficult!*
- Conduct yourself in an inclusive, respectful, and professional manner at all times
- Dress for the weather (which, in the Berkshires is hard to predict!)
- Bring snacks if you think you'll need some
